P.E.

P.E. days-Tuesday

In PE this term the children will continue to work on gymnastics. The children will begin to look at how different equipment can be used within gymnastics and use their ideas individually and as a pair to create routines and perform in front of peers.

The children will also begin to participate in multi-skill sessions to improve their hand eye co-ordination. This will include sending and receiving objects and looking at how to incorporate these skills into game situations.

PSHE

The children will focus on the theme 'Healthy and Unhealthy Relationships'.

They will learn about respect, ways in which we are the same and different to others, how to play, work co-operatively, talk about and share opinions. They will identify how people may feel if they experience hurtful behaviour or bullying both offline and online.

The children will looks at ways to be physically healthy.

Art and Design
