Parent Support Advisor - Our Parent Support Advisor, Mrs Ava Williams is in school on Mondays and Tuesdays to help you with any issues you may have.

Medicines - It is school policy that we can only have medicines in school that are prescribed by the doctor which need to be administered 4 times a day. Medicines have to have the Doctor's label on them and must be brought to the school office and a school medical form completed. If you need to give your child medicine that is not prescribed by the Doctor you are welcome to come into school yourself and give it to them, just notify the office staff.



Sickness/Stomach bug - If your child is absent due to a sickness/stomach bug, our school policy states that they have to have 48hrs clearance before they can return to school. Thank you for your co-operation.

Leave of Absence Requests - Following guidelines from the Local Authority regarding Leave of Absence Requests, a letter must be sent to Mrs Roche, Headteacher at least 10 days in advance of the first day requested. This letter should state the dates and reason for your leave of absence request.
