

Please visit [www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com) and activate your account via the Account login area on the home page of the site. **This method is for payments of School Visits, Breakfast and Afterschool Club and Wraparound Care only.** ParentPay went live on Monday 5th November 2018, making the school a more cash-free environment. As no money is kept in school can I remind you that payments for After School Clubs, ie Karate, Dance etc. we now need to have the exact money, was we cannot give change.
