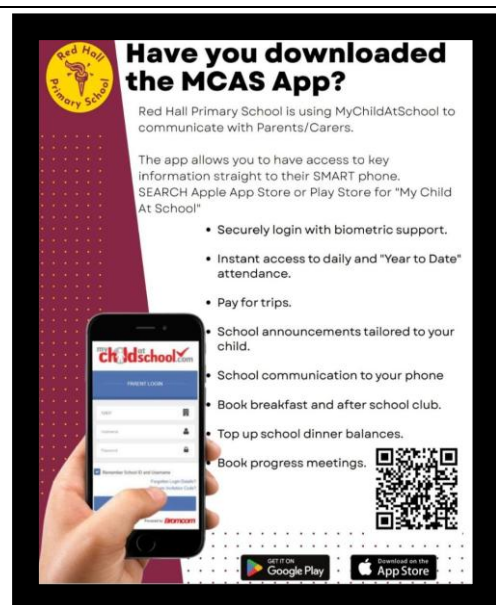

How do I add money to my child's account?

To add dinner money to your child's account via MyChildAtSchool (MCAS), follow these steps:

1. Log into the MCAS website or app.
2. Navigate to the 'Dinner' module.
3. Click on the 'Add Dinner Money' button.
4. Enter the amount you wish to top-up and click 'Add to Basket'.
5. Fill out your debit/credit card details.
