The children will identify, name, draw and label basic parts of the human body. They will explore the five senses and relate these to the body parts.



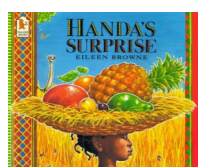
## Art

## History

The children will research The Great fire of London and the famous diarist, Samuel Pepys. They will also understand the failure of the Gunpowder Plot and Guy Fawkes.



## Geography
