

Science: Animals including humans

We will learn that some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement. We will then identify that animals, including humans, need the right types of nutrition.

Rocks and Soils

We will learn about the different types of rocks and how they are formed. We will then move on to discover how fossils are formed and all about the different soil types.

Through our units, we will develop our working scientific skills through a range of practical enquiries.

Art

We will improve our mastery of sculpture skills. We will explore the idea of how a local area can influence artists and create a piece of pottery.

Music

We are very lucky to have Fife lessons provided by Dudley Performing Arts for the year. At the end of the year, we will have a performance to showcase our learning.

English

We will start with our place value of punctuation and grammar unit. In this, we will revisit our knowledge of different types of nouns, verbs and how to use these correctly in sentences. Following this, we will compose a non-fiction piece of writing all about pre-historic creatures linking to our Stone Age topic.

Guided Reading

In guided reading we will read a range of texts linked to our science and topic learning. We will develop our fluency and understanding of vocabulary and extend our VIPERS skills to answer a range of questions about texts.

Maths: Statistics/Place value/ Calculation

We will start with recapping KS1 knowledge using number bonds to 10, adding 3 addends and recapping commutative law. We will then begin to look at place value up to 1000, where we partition numbers, add and subtracting using mental strategies and columns.

History Stone Age- Iron Age

In History, we will learn about the period of history from the Stone Age through to the Iron Age. We will find out how and where they lived and about the animals who lived at the time.

Geography

We will learn about the geographical features of the UK and our region.

RE

Our first focus religion will be Islam. We will learn about the Qur'an, the importance of the Five Pillars of Islam and how Muslims pray. Then we will look at the topic of Care and Concern and how different religions and cultures show this.

P.E.

We will take part in a variety of team games to develop our skills, knowledge and teamwork. We will do fitness activities focussing on co-ordination, agility and balance. Our first topic is multi sports.
