

Welcome back to you all! We hope that you have had a wonderful break. Children have come back to school with such fantastic learning attitudes and all staff have been really impressed with the positive impressions that your children have made in their first week.

I am delighted to share with you our new Attendance Rewards that children have had explained to them in assembly this week. We will continue with announcing the top class each week, with children collecting a raffle ticket if they have been to school each week and placing in the display. This will be drawn each half-term. The more tickets a child receives, the greater the chance they have of winning. We draw a ticket for each Phase (Early Years, KS1 and KS2). In addition to this, we will be hosting five special attendance Reward events throughout the year. Only children who have achieved 97% attendance or above will be invited to these events that will be hosted after school. Each half term there will be a fresh chance to have success with achieving an invite. The first date for this is 9th November. We will also be giving out Attendance award badges for each term (Autumn, Spring and Summer) for children who have achieved 97% attendance or above.

Improving attendance continues to be a key focus for Red Hall Primary School. This is shown by the difference in our data and National data for attendance.

A child is classed as being persistently absent if they miss 10% or more of their possible sessions. We will continue to update you how attendance is improving. We will want to work with you if your child's attendance last year was in the Persistent Absence category.
