Science

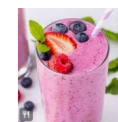
Living things and their habitat

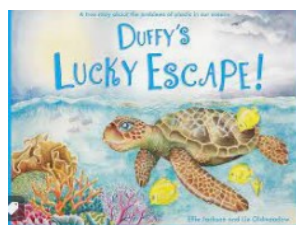
Art and DT

History
