Science

Animals and Other Living Things

The children are going to be looking at the Differences between living and dead things and things that have never been alive.

Animals and Other Living Things

The children are going to be looking at animals and plants that live in a beach habitat and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants.



Art and Design

In Art the children will be focusing on printing, where they will be creating their own tiles to represent under the water creature and plants.

In DT the children will be focusing on nutrition in order to create and follow a set of instructions to make a fruit smoothie, using cutting, peeling and grating skills.



Computing

The children will be programming—a robot algorithms. This unit aims to develop pupils' understanding of instructions in sequences and the use of logical reasoning to predict outcomes. Pupils will use given commands in different orders to investigate how the order affects the outcome. Pupils will also learn about design in programming.
