#### WRAP AROUND CARE: Breakfast and After School Club

Do you know that we will charge you for late collection from school? Your child/ren will be taken to After School Club. There is a charge of £4.50 for anytime from the end of the school day till 4.30pm and a further charge will be given for collection up to 5.45pm of £7.50.

This year the debt that has been created by families not paying their bills and for late collection of children and not paying the bill has amounted to £2,500. This has had to be paid for from the main school fund which should be used for the education of children. We will pass details on to anyone who has not paid their bills to the Debt Collection service of Dudley Council.

We are currently reviewing the service of the Wrap Around Care in light of this misuse by families and will update you any changes.
